Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits
that the petitioners have been implicated in connection with the
instant case for alleged recovery of 312 grams of heroin and
investigating agency on conclusion of investigation has already
submitted charge-sheet before the learned special court.

6 months 25 days and may be granted bail on any stringent
conditions.
