C.R.M. (NDPS) 90 of 2026

In Re: An application for bail under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Murutia Police Station Case No.368 of 2024 dated 18.12.2024 under Sections 21(c)/25/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act and charge-sheet submitted under Sections 21(c)/25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985;

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been implicated for alleged recovery of 500 bottles of phenseydl and is in custody for 1 year 1 month. Petitioner has enclosed the copy of the evidence in respect of the four witnesses which has been recorded in connection with the instant case.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

I have considered the depositions of P.W.1 and P.W.2 and the period of detention of the present petitioner and on an assessment of the same, I am of the view that further detention of the petitioner, at this stage, is unwarranted.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Joni Mondal @ Sukur @ Jani Mondal shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court, under NDPS Act, Nadia. If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned trial court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Nadia without the prior permission of the learned special court. If there is any violation of the aforesaid conditions, learned trial court would cancel the bail of the petitioner without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 90 of 2026 is allowed.
