Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a victim of circumstances. Some amount of money was credited from an unknown source to his account. He is a daily labour.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail. He submits that this is a case of Cyber Crime. Several persons are involved and there are several victims in this case. Money did not only get credited to the bank account of the petitioner, but also was withdrawn on the same day in cash.

Considering the above and the other incriminating materials available in the case diary, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
