Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits  
that petitioner is in custody for 11 months and allegedly there  
was recovery of 115 Kgs. of Ganja. Learned advocate submits  
that as charge sheet has been submitted, petitioner may be  
released on bail.

On the other hand, learned advocate appearing for the  
State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that commercial  
quantity of contraband has been seized.

Having considered that the rigors of Section 37 of the  
NDPS Act is attracted, I am not inclined to release the  
petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 107 of 2026 is **dismissed**.
