1. This revisional application seeks expeditious disposal of Matrimonial Suit No.314 of 2024 pending before the learned Judge, Family Court, Tamluk, Purba Medinipur.
2. In view of the nature of the order proposed to be passed, prior service of the revisional application along with a notice is not being directed, however, the petitioner shall remain obliged to serve a copy of the revisional application along with a copy of this order upon the opposite party within a week from date.
