Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for a year and charge-sheet has already been submitted but the case is yet to be committed to the Court of Sessions. Other accused persons have been granted bail.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and draws the attention of the Court to the medical report and the complicity of the petitioner.

Having considered the period of detention of the present petitioner, I am of the view that further incarceration is unwarranted. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed.**

As such, petitioner namely, **Sukumar Mandal** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten

Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Malda.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date before the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of district of Malda without the prior permission of the learned Trial Court.

Thus, the application for bail being CRM (M) No. 195 of 2026 is **allowed**.

Report submitted by the State be kept with the record.
