CRM (NDPS) 126 of 2026

In re : An Application for **Bail** under Section **439** of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with **Lalgola PS Case No. 219 of 2025 dated 14th March, 2025 u/s 20(b)(ii)(c)/29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 relating to NDPS Case No. 55 of 2025.**

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been implicated on the basis of alleged recovery of 22 kg 880 gm of *ganja* and is in custody for 10 months.

Additionally, it has been submitted that since the investigation has been completed and charge-sheet has been submitted before the learned jurisdictional court, on any stringent condition, the petitioner may be released on bail.

Learned advocate for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail.

I have taken into account the period of detention of the present petitioner and I am of the view that further custodial detention of the present petitioner is unwarranted.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Allowed.**

Accordingly, the petitioner viz, Rajkumar Sarkar shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Judge, Special Court under NDPS Act-cum-learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, 2nd Court, Berhampore, Murshidabad.

If on bail, the petitioner shall also make himself physically available on each and every date so fixed by the learned trial court and shall not leave the district of Murshidabad without prior intimation to the learned trial court.

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 126 of 2026 is **allowed.**
