Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody for one year seven months and till date only one witness has been completely examined while the evidence of PW2 is in progress.

Learned advocate for the State has produced the Case Diary and it is found that the allegations have its genesis in a matrimonial dispute between the mother of the victim and father of the victim.

Having considered the period of detention of the present petitioner which is for one year seven months and the prosecution has relied upon 13 witnesses, I direct that after the cross-examination of the victim is over the petitioner be released on bail

on such terms and conditions as the learned Special Court deems fit and proper.

With the aforesaid observations, CRM (M) 269 of 2026 is disposed of.
