Affidavit of service filed by the petitioner is taken on record.

None appears for the Panchayat despite service.

The petitioner alleges that the private respondent is raising construction on his land without obtaining any sanction from the concerned Panchayat. The petitioner submitted a representation before the concerned authority in this regard on 22nd July, 2024 and seeks consideration of the same.

Learned counsel for the private respondent submits that no construction is being raised by the private respondent in the petitioner's land.

Upon consideration of the submission made on behalf of the parties, this Court directs the Pradhan, Raninagar-I Gram Panchayat, being the 2nd respondent herein, to consider and dispose of the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 22nd July, 2024 within

six weeks from the date of communication of this order upon affording reasonable opportunity of hearing to all concerned including the petitioner and the private respondent, in accordance with law.

The decision taken by the authority shall be communicated to the parties within a week thereof.

In the event the construction allegedly raised by the private respondent is found to be illegal/unauthorized, the concerned authority shall take necessary steps in accordance with law.

The writ petition is disposed of accordingly.

There shall, however, be no order as to costs.

Since no affidavit is invited, the allegations contained in the writ petition are deemed not to have been admitted.
