This is an application wherein petitioner has prayed for expeditious disposal of the protest petition filed by the petitioner before the trial court under section 173(8) of the Cr.P.C. on 22nd July, 2025.

Mr. Gupta, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his application concerning objection against the investigation was filed long back but the court below has kept it pending for a considerable period of time, as such, necessary direction may be passed to the court below for expeditious disposal of the said application.
