Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits
that the subject matter of the case relates to recovery of 449 bottles
of phensedyl from the joint possession of the petitioners. It has also
been pointed out that on 15.10.2025 the Hon'ble Apex Court in
Special Leave to Appeal (Crl.) No.15735 of 2025 has been pleased to
reject the bail of the petitioners.

Learned advocate for the State, on the other hand,
