Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is in custody for 86 days and he has
surrendered before the Court.

Learned advocate for the State submits that the case
was registered in the year 2021 and the petitioner having
evaded the process of law is not entitled to the relief. The
prayer for anticipatory bail was rejected.

Having considered the totality of the circumstances
particularly when 184 bottles of Phensedyl were recovered and
the petitioner was not available before a Court of law, I direct
the petitioner to approach this Court after 6 months.

In the meantime, State would put in efforts to conclude at least 6 witnesses.

At this stage, CRM (NDPS) 175 of 2026 is **dismissed**.

No unnecessary adjournment be given to any of the parties and the trial of the case would continue inspite of any resolution taken by the local bar.
