that petitioner is in custody for 2 years and the vulnerable
witnesses have already been examined.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail and submits that there are multiple stabbed injuries being
inflicted upon the injured.

that only one witness till date has been partly examined and
the evidence of the vital witnesses are still to be examined.

Having considered the gravity of the offence I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.
