Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is in custody for 1 year and 7 months and
pursuant to the earlier direction two seizure list witnesses have
already been examined.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail and submits that huge quantity of Phensedyl were
recovered and so far as the evidence of the seizure list
witnesses are concerned, the same corroborates the
prosecution case.

Having considered the same, I am not inclined to
release the petitioner on bail.

Learned Trial Court would expedite the process of trial.

Consequently, CRM (NDPS) 181 of 2026 is **dismissed**.
