**CRM (A) 329 of 2026**

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C./Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with **Liluah** P.S. Case No.**450 of 2012** dated **21.06.2012** under Sections **147/148/149/325/326/307/364** of the IPC read with Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not aware that such an FIR was lodged against him in 2012. He was also not aware about submission of charge sheet. He came to know about the pendency of this case only after the proclamation was issued.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State strongly opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has remained absconding since 2012, a proclamation has been issued against him and the incriminating materials available in the case diary, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
