C.R.M. (NDPS) 200 of 2026

In Re : An Application for bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Kotwali Police Station Case No. 1256 of 2025 dated 15.11.2025 under Sections 21(b)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that intermediate quantity of heroin was recovered from the custody of the present petitioner and the petitioner is in custody for 84 days. Charge-sheet has already been submitted and it has also been alleged that in the present case, there has been no videography by the investigating agency.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the quantum of seizure of contraband in the present case and the period of detention of the petitioner, I am of the view that further incarceration of the present petitioner in connection with the instant case is

unwarranted. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed.**

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Niharul Islam @ Nahirul Islam** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-, with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under the NDPS Act, Nadia at Krishnagar.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Nadia without prior permission of the learned Special Court.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 200 of 2026, is, thus, disposed of.
