Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner is in custody for 210 days. According to the
learned advocate petitioner is a driver of the vehicle.

On the other hand, learned advocate for the State
opposes the prayer for bail and submits that there were
recovery of 80.99 Kgs. of Ganja.

Having considered the quantum of seizure which is of
commercial quantity, I am of the view Section 37 of the NDPS
Act is attracted. As such the prayer for bail of the petitioner is
rejected at this stage.

Thus, CRM (NDPS) 202 of 2026 is **dismissed**.
