CRM (NDPS) 233 of 2026

In re : An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with Kumagranj Police Station Case No. 260 of 2025 dated 15.07.2025 u/s 21(c)/22(c)/23(c) of the NDPS Act (corresponding to NDPS Case No. 45 of 2025 and Special Case No. 45 of 2025).

The subject-matter of the case involves 125 bottles of phensedyl and the petitioner is in custody for seven months. It is also submitted that charges have been framed.

Learned advocate for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail.

Having considered the period of detention of the present petitioner and the fact that there is no possibility of the trial concluding in the near future, I am of the view that further incarceration of the present petitioner is unwarranted.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Allowed.**

Accordingly, the petitioner viz, **Manjurul Mondal @ Mandal** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Special Judge under NDPS Act-cum-ADJ, 3rd Court, Dakshin Dinajpur at Balurghat.

If on bail, the petitioner shall also make himself physically available on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special court and shall not leave the district of Dakshin Dinajpur without prior intimation to the learned Special court.

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 233 of 2026 is **allowed**.

Pending application(s), if any, is also disposed of.
