1. Heard the learned counsels for the petitioner, de-facto complainant and the State.
2. Perused the case diary.
3. Considering the above and the materials available in the case diary including the injury report which, however, does not show infliction of any grievous injury, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
4. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to further conditions that the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation and shall not threaten or

intimidate the witnesses. The petitioner shall meet the I.O once a week till submission of report in final form.

5. Accordingly, the application for anticipatory bail is allowed.
6. Urgent photostat certified copy of this order, if applied for, be given to the parties upon compliance with requisite formalities.
