Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that from 3 accused persons, 23 Kgs. of Ganja were allegedly
recovered.

Learned advocate for the State draws the attention of
the Court to the seizure list.

I have taken into account the overall circumstances and
it has been also informed that date has been fixed for
consideration of charges.

Having considered the quantum of seizure in the
present case, I direct the learned Judge, Special Court, under

NDPS Act, Howrah to release the petitioner on bail after the stage of consideration of charges are over.

Learned Court would allow the petitioner to furnish bond on such terms and conditions as the learned Court deems fit and proper thereby ensuring his further appearance before the Court in course of trial.

With the aforesaid observations CRM (NDPS) 211 of 2026 is disposed of.
