In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023/ Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 in connection with Raghunathganj Police Station Case No. 579 of 2024 dated 01.06.2024 under sections 395/397/412/109/120B/202/212 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 13/14 of the Foreigners Act, 1946.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 1 year and 8 months and out of 26 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 16 witnesses have already been examined.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that petitioner was identified in the T.I. Parade and there has been recovery from the petitioner.

Petitioner is in custody for a considerable period of time.

Learned Trial Court is directed to fix a schedule of 3 dates once in a month and conclude the trial at the earliest.

Memo of evidence submitted by the State be kept with the record.

With the aforesaid directions CRM (M) 306 of 2026 is **dismissed** at this stage.
