Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that he is similarly situated as other accused persons who has
been granted bail. The subject matter of recovery of the present
case is 25.56 Kgs. of Ganja. Petitioner is in custody for more
than 1 year and 10 months.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail.

I find from the records of the case that in CRM (NDPS)
1727 of 2025 similarly placed accused person has already been
granted bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

Petitioner, namely, **Md. Akil @ Md. Wakil** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each. One of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned Special Court under NDPS Act cum Learned Additional Sessions Judge, 3rd Court, Asansol, Paschim Bardhaman.

If on bail petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of Paschim Bardhaman without the prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 217 of 2026 is **allowed**.

All parties shall act in terms of server copy of the order downloaded from the official website of this Court.
