1. This revisional application seeks expeditious disposal of an application for injunction in connection with Title Suit No.295 of 2019 pending before the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 2nd Court at Barrackpore.

In view of the nature of the order proposed to be passed, prior service of the revisional application along with a notice is not being directed, however, the petitioners shall remain obliged to serve a copy of the revisional application along with a copy of this order upon the opposite parties within a week from date.

Having heard the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner and having considered the material on record, this revisional application is disposed of by requesting the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 2nd Court at Barrackpore to dispose of the application for injunction filed in Title Suit No.295 of 2019 as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of three months from the next date fixed without granting any unnecessary

adjournment to either of the parties.

4. With the aforesaid observations, CO 358 of 2026 stands disposed of. No costs.
