Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that the subject matter of the recovery in the present case
relates to 21.464 Kgs. of Ganja. Petitioner is in custody for 2
years and 4 months.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail and submits that the evidence of the 2 witnesses have been
completed and prosecution would at the earliest conclude the
evidence of the witnesses concerned.

I have taken into account the subject matter of recovery
in the present case, the period of detention of the present

petitioner and is of the view further incarceration is unwarranted.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

Petitioner, namely, **Sk. Azad** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each. One of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned Bench-1 Judge, City Sessions Court, Calcutta.

If on bail petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of Kolkata without the prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 220 of 2026 is **allowed**.
