Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits
that the petitioners are in custody for 263 days and the
quantum of recovery is 4.5 Kgs. of Codeine Mixture.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail but having considered the time frame required for
concluding the trial I am of the view that further detention of
the petitioners is unwarranted.

As such the prayer for bail of the petitioners is allowed.

Petitioners, namely, (1) **Sk. Milon @ Sk. Milan**, (2) **Sk.
Azfar @ Sk. Kalo** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees
Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/-

(Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each. One of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned Judge, Special Court under NDPS Act, Suri, Birbhum.

If on bail petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of Birbhum without the prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 242 of 2026 is **allowed**.

All parties shall act in terms of server copy of the order downloaded from the official website of this Court.
