Affidavit-of-service filed by the petitioner be kept with the record.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for about 82 days.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

I have taken into account the statement of the victim. There is added plea also of the petitioner that he would be sitting in the Higher Secondary examination, 2026, accordingly, the petitioner be released on bail. Thus, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed.**

Accordingly, petitioner namely, **Anindya Barai @ Ani @ Aninda Barui @ Aninday Bairai** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each,

one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned Special Court under the POCSO Act, Barasat, North 24 Parganas.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date before the learned trial Court in seisin of the case and shall not enter the jurisdiction of Barasat Police Station except for the purposes of attending the Court.

Learned Special Court, if required, would impose such other conditions as he deems fit and proper for ensuring the presence of the petitioner in course of the trial.

Accordingly, the application for bail being CRM (M) No. 314 of 2026 is **allowed**.

All parties shall act in terms of server copy of the order downloaded from the official website of this Court.
