In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Khairasole Police Station case no. 102 of 2025 dated 18.05.2025 under Sections 21(c) of the of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the subject matter of recovery of 5.35 kgs of codeine mixtures allegedly from the possession of the present petitioner.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Records of the case reflect that charges have already been framed.

Having considered that the petitioner is in custody for eight months, I am of the view that further incarceration is unwarranted. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

Accordingly, petitioner namely, **Hasibul Rahaman** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction

of the learned Judge, Special Court under NDPS Act, Birbhum at Suri.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned trial Court in seisin of the case and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of Birbhum without the prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail in CRM (NDPS) 228 of 2026 is **allowed**.
