Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for three months nine days and has surrendered before the learned jurisdictional court on 04.11.2025.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that 6000 bottles of phensedyl were recovered from a bolero car which belongs to the present petitioner.

Having considered the quantum of seizure and the petitioner having surrendered within the fold of law very recently, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail at this stage.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is
Rejected.

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 249 of 2026 is **dismissed.**
