Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Perused the case diary.

Considering the incriminating materials available in the case diary including the statements of the victim made before the learned Magistrate, her injury report and the statement of a neighbour and immediate post occurrence witness and the fact that substantially similarly circumstanced co-accused denied the benefit of anticipatory bail by this Court, I do not consider this to be a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, rejected.
