Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that although the subject-matter of the case relates to alleged recovery of 600 bottles of phensedyl, but petitioner's implication in the case is on the basis of statement of co-accused.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail, but is unable to refute the contention of the petitioner that petitioner has been implicated on the basis of statement of co-accused.

Having considered that there has been no recovery from the present petitioner, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Md. Mohsin Raza @ Md. Mohsin Reza @ Mohsin** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-, with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under the NDPS Act, Raiganj, Uttar Dinajpur.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of Uttar Dinajpur without prior permission of the learned Special Court.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 260 of 2026, is, thus, disposed of.
