2. The petitioner's prayer seeking appointment on compassionate ground on the death of his father on June 23, 2019 is pending consideration at the end of the authority for a considerable period of time.

Without entering into the merit of the claim of the petitioner, the instant writ petition stands disposed of by directing the competent authority of the respondents to take a decision on the petitioner's prayer seeking compassionate appointment strictly in accordance with law, at the earliest, but positively within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of this order.
