Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner is in custody for 1 year and 3 months and he
was shown arrested in connection with the instant case.

According to the learned advocate petitioner has been
arrested on the basis of statement of co-accused and there are
no materials so far as the subject matter of the case is
concerned.

On the other hand, learned advocate for the State
opposes the prayer for bail and submits that petitioner was
funding in the cultivation of the contraband.

I have taken into account the period of detention of the petitioner and the fact that other accused persons have been released on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the present petitioner be allowed.

Accordingly, Petitioner, namely, **Kitabul Sk. @ Tarkata** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each. One of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned Judge, Special 3rd Court, NDPS Act, Purba Bardhaman.

If on bail, petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of Purba Bardhaman without the prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, CRM (NDPS) 275 of 2026 is **allowed**.
