Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner draws the
attention of the Court to the order dated 3rd February, 2026 in
CRM (M) 2050 of 2025 and submits that the petitioner is
similarly placed as the other accused who has been granted
bail.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for
bail but is unable to refute that the petitioner is not on a
different footing than the accused who has been granted bail.

In view of the petitioner being in custody for 5 years
and 8 months, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

Accordingly, Petitioner, namely, **Firoj Molla @ Feroj Molla** shall furnish bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each. One of whom must be local to the satisfaction of Learned Judge, Special Court under POCSO Act at Alipore, 24 Parganas South.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed before the learned Trial Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of District of 24 Parganas South without the prior permission of the Learned Special Court.

Additionally, petitioner shall not enter the jurisdiction of Basanti Police Station without prior permission of the Inspector-in-Charge, Basanti Police Station.

Thus, CRM (M) 439 of 2026 is **allowed**.

All parties shall act in terms of server copy of the order downloaded from the official website of this Court.
