Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits  
that the petitioner is in custody for 1 year and 10 months and  
till date charges have not been framed. Further, petitioner has  
been falsely implicated as even the victim has not taken the  
name of the petitioner.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for  
bail and submits that although there has been delay in the  
present case, but the accusations, as is reflected from the  
statement of the victim, is heinous. Victim happens to be a  
specially abled child.

Learned advocate for the defacto complainant is present and opposes the prayer for bail.

I have taken into account the period of custody of the present petitioner. There are various reasons which have been assigned, but without entering into the same, at this stage, I am not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Learned Trial Court is to ensure that on the next date, the stage of charges are overcome and the victim is examined at the earliest.

At this stage, CRM (M) 520 of 2026 is **dismissed**.
