Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was separately arrested who has been involved along with the other accused persons thereby foisting a case for recovery of commercial quantity of contraband.

Learned advocate for the NCB submits a report and opposes the prayer for bail.

I have taken into account the quantum of seizure made by the investigating agency which is 54.210 kg of ganja.

The background of the case also reflects that different persons were available in a train proceeding towards Bardhaman from Dinhata.

Having considered the totality of the circumstances, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Rejected.**

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail after the evidence of the seizure list witnesses is over.

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 324 of 2026 is **dismissed.**

Pending application(s), if any, is also disposed of.
