CRM (NDPS) 328 of 2026

In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Golabari Police Station case no. 419 of 2025 dated 11.12.2025 under Sections 21(b)/29 of the of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the subject matter of the case relates to seizure of 126 grams of heroin. Petitioner is in custody for 52 days and he has been implicated on the basis of the statement of co-accused and from him 7.72 grams of heroin was recovered.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail but is unable to refute the contention that petitioner has been detained on the basis of the statement of co-accused and there has been recovery to the extent of only 7.72 grams of heroin.

Having considered the quantum of seizure, I am of the view that further detention of the petitioner is unwarranted, as such the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

Accordingly, petitioner namely, **Md. Jamil @ Nata Jamil** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs. 20,000/-

(Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under NDPS Act, 3rd Court, Howrah.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date before the learned trial Court in seisin of the case and shall not leave the jurisdiction of district of Howrah without prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail in CRM (NDPS) 328 of 2026 is **allowed**.
