This is an application wherein petitioner has prayed for a direction for expeditious disposal of the proceedings in connection with ACGR 5444/2023 presently pending before learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Alipore.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the complainant preferred an application under section 439(2) Cr.P.C. before the learned District and Sessions Judge, Alipore and the said court rejected the said petition on 24.04.2025 and since then the case record is lying with the District Judge and the hearing of the case get stalled. Therefore, the petitioner has prayed for a necessary direction.
