Learned advocate appearing for the state respondents hands up to court a copy of a report dated January 31, 2026 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, 1st Court Raiganj, Uttar Dinajpur, prepared in compliance with an order dated January 29, 2026 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, 1st Court Raiganj, Uttar Dinajpur and submits that the certified copy of the documents as requested by the petitioner are ready.
