This revisional application seeks expeditious disposal of an application under Order 39 Rule 4 filed by the petitioner seeking vacation of an order passed on an application for temporary injunction in Title Suit No. 1429 of 2025 pending before the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), 1st Court at Barasat, North 24 Parganas.
2. In view of the nature of the order proposed to be passed direction for prior service of copy of this application along with notice on the opposite parties is not being made, however, the petitioner shall remain obliged to serve a copy of this application along with a copy of this order upon the opposite parties within a week from date.
3. Having heard the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner and having considered the material on record, this revisional application is disposed of by requesting the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), 1st Court at Barasat, North 24 Parganas to dispose of

the pending application under Order 39 Rule 4 of the Code filed in connection with the said Title Suit No. 1429 of 2025 before the said court as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of two months from the next date fixed without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties.

4. With the above observations, CO. 660 of 2026 stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
