In Re: An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/Under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Sankrail Police Station case no. 746 of 2023 dated 01.10.2023 under Sections 20(B)(ii)(c)/25/29 of the of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Petitioner is similarly situated as the other accused person who has been granted bail in SLP (Crl.) 15405 of 2025.

Having considered the same, I am inclined to release the petitioner bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed.**

Accordingly, petitioner namely, **Samar Mistri** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under NDPS Act cum Additional District & Sessions Judge, 3rd Court, Howrah.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed before the learned trial Court in seisin of the case and shall not leave the jurisdiction of district of Howrah without the prior permission of the learned Special Court.

Thus, the prayer for bail in CRM (NDPS) 379 of 2026 is **allowed.**
