- 1.** The revisional application has been preferred by the wife/petitioner praying for transfer of Matrimonial Suit No.2360 of 2025 from the Court of Learned Additional District Judge, F.T.C.-III, at Barrackpore to the Court of Learned Additional District Judge, at Alipore, District-South 24 Parganas.
- 2.** On hearing the learned counsels for the parties and on perusal of the materials on record, it appears that the Matrimonial Suit has been filed in the Court of Learned Additional District Judge, F.T.C.-III, at

Barrackpore, by the husband/opposite party herein.

3. The petitioner/wife herein resides at 120, Satyen Roy Road, P.O.-Behala, P.S.-Behala, Kolkata 700034, along with her child aged five(5) years.
4. Considering the said difficulty of the petitioner/wife to travel to Barrackpore on regular basis, when she has a child to look after, this Court relying upon the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***N.C.V. Aishwarya vs A.S. Saravana Karthik Sha, in Civil Appeal No(s). 4894 of 2022 (arising out of SLP (C) No(s). 16465 of 2021), decided on July 18, 2022, (Para 11, 12) and on consent of both parties***, directs that Matrimonial Suit No. 2360 of 2025 be withdrawn from the Court of Learned Additional District Judge, F.T.C.-III, at Barrackpore and be transferred to the Court of Learned District/Additional District Judge, at Alipore, District-South 24 Parganas.
5. Learned District/Additional District Judge, at Alipore, South 24 parganas,

shall proceed with the suit in accordance with law with due notice upon both the parties.

6. Keeping in mind the case of the parties herein, the Learned District Judge shall be at liberty to permit the opposite party to **appear virtually**, if such prayer is made.
7. **CO 690 of 2026 is disposed of.**
