1. In terms of the order dated 8th April, 2026, Inspector-in-Charge, Asansol (South) Police Station has filed an affidavit which was affirmed on 17th April, 2026 and same is taken on record. Copy of the affidavit filed today is also made over to the learned advocate representing the petitioner.
