Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner prays for bail as the petitioner is in custody since July, 2025. Petitioner claims himself to be innocent and submits that he and his wife has been falsely implicated in connection with the instant case.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

I have taken into account the locus of the present petitioner and his wife in relation to the materials which has surfaced in the Case Diary.

Having considered that the case against the petitioner and his wife are under the BNS, Immoral Traffic Prevention Act as well as the POCSO act and the petitioner and his wife are the tenant of the property wherein the misdeeds were being carried out, I am of the

view that this is not the proper stage of the case to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner in CRM (M) 580 of 2026 is **dismissed**.
