Leave is granted to correct the cause title.

Report filed on behalf of the State is taken on record.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the de facto complainant submits that the petitioners' application for anticipatory bail had earlier been rejected by this Court on 12.09.2025 in CRM (A) 2913 of 2025. By suppressing this, the present application has been filed. In fact, the petitioner has filed another application for anticipatory bail in respect of the same case being CRM (A) 833 of 2026.

It is indeed very surprising that the Investigating Agency has not been able to apprehend the petitioner and even after rejection of anticipatory bail by this Court, the petitioner is moving one application for anticipatory bail after another without disclosing the rejection of the earlier application for anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the de facto complainant files a copy of the complaint filed by the alleged victim that the petitioner and other accused had been threatening the victim all this long.

The anticipatory bail application is dismissed as not maintainable.

For the above non-disclosure, the petitioner shall pay a cost of Rs. 10,000/- to the State Legal Services Authorities within fortnight from this date. Within a week thereafter, the petitioner shall file a receipt for such payment before the Registrar General, High Court at Calcutta.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Paschim Medinipur for necessary action.
