1. Report filed on behalf of the State is taken on record.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that other than the statement of co-accused, there is no other incriminating material available against the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail. He refers to the report and submits that there is a criminal antecedent of the petitioner under the provisions of the NDPS Act. Moreover, there are telephonic conversations between the petitioner and the accused from whom the contraband was recovered at the relevant time.
4. Considering the above and the other incriminating materials available in the case diary and the restriction contained in Section 37 of the NDPS Act, I do not

consider this to be a fit case to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, the application for anticipatory bail is rejected.
