1. Affidavit of service filed in Court today is taken on record.
2. Leave granted to the advocate on record of the private respondent to file *vakalatnama* in the department in course of the day.
3. The instant writ petition was filed praying for a direction upon the Sub-Divisional Officer to conclude the proceeding initiated under the West Bengal Public Land (Eviction of Unauthorized Occupants) Act, 1962 for removal of the unauthorized occupants.
4. Learned advocate representing the State respondents has produced a copy of the order dated 30th December, 2025 passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Baruipur, South 24 Parganas wherefrom it appears that the proceeding has been concluded and the Block

Development Officer was directed to demolish/remove the unauthorized construction.
