CRM (NDPS) 411 of 2026

In re : An Application for Bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973/under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023 in connection with Kumarganj Police Station Case No. 77 of 2025 dated 02.03.2025 u/s 21(b)/22(b)/23(b)/27A of the NDPS Act corresponding to NDPS Case No. 11 of 2025.

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for one year twenty days and the subject-matter of the alleged recovery in the present case is 50 bottles of phensedyl.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

I have heard the submissions of the learned counsel of the respective parties. The records speak that charges have already been framed and five of the witnesses have been examined out of the 14 witnesses whom the prosecution intends to rely upon to prove its case.

Having considered the period of detention of the present petitioner and the stage of the case which reflects

that some time will be consumed for concluding the trial, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **Allowed.**

Accordingly, the petitioner viz, **Saifur Molla** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge under NDPS Act-cum-ADJ, 3rd Court, Balurghat, Dakshin Dinajpur.

If on bail, the petitioner shall also make himself physically available on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special court and shall not leave the district of Dakshin Dinajpur without prior intimation to the learned Special court.

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 411 of 2026 is **allowed.**

Pending application(s), if any, is also disposed of.
