C.R.M. (NDPS) 416 of 2026

In Re: An application for bail under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 corresponding to Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with Kaliachak Police Station Case No.1447 of 2024 dated 13.09.2024 under Sections 21(c)/27A/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 read with Section 61(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023;

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 555 days and the two seizure list witnesses whom prosecution have relied upon did not support the prosecution case and, as such, have been declared hostile.

On the other hand, learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that there were alleged recovery of 3.476 kgs. of brown sugar along with an arms and magazine.

Having considered the fact that rest of the witnesses belong to the Government department and no more independent witnesses are left, I am not inclined to further detain the petitioner.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is

allowed. The petitioner, namely, Bodrujjaman @ Badal shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court, under NDPS Act-cum-learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, 4th Court, Malda. If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date fixed by the learned special court and shall not leave the district of Malda without prior permission of the learned special court.

Accordingly, CRM(NDPS) 416 of 2026 is allowed.
