This revisional application has been filed seeking expeditious disposal of two applications under Order XXII Rule 6 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 filed by both, the petitioners as well as the opposite party in Ejectment Suit No. 40 of 2013 pending before the learned Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Sealdah.
