C.R.M. (NDPS) 504 of 2026

In Re : An Application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 corresponding to Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed in connection with New Barrackpore Police Station Case No. 318 of 2020 dated 05.09.2020 under Section 21(c) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that there has been alleged recovery of 1.5 kgs. of Codeine Mixture and the petitioner is in custody for 5 years 7 months.

Learned advocate appearing for the State, on the other hand, opposes the prayer for bail. It has been submitted that prosecution has relied upon eight witnesses, out of which only one witness till date has been examined and the evidence of PW-2 and PW-3 is in progress.

Having considered the period of detention of the petitioner, I am of the opinion that further detention of the present petitioner in connection with the instant case is unwarranted. As such, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is **allowed.**

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., **Dilip Mondal @ Tukai** shall be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-, with two sureties of Rs.10,000/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under the NDPS Act, Barrackpore.

If on bail, the petitioner shall be physically present on each and every date so fixed by the learned Special Court and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the district of North 24-Parganas without prior permission of the learned Special Court.

The application for bail, being CRM (NDPS) 504 of 2026, is, thus, disposed of.
